***INDUSTRIAL ATTACHMENT (IA) REQUIREMENTS**

Students must satisfy the following requirements to be eligible for the Industrial Attachment (IA) component:

AGE

Must be at least 18 years old on commencement of the IA

ACADEMIC

Successfully PASSED all 8 modules

COURSE ATTENDANCE REQUIREMENT

- Maintained their course attendance rate of at least 90%
- Pass an interview/selection process
- Students who do not meet the above requirements OR did not succeed in securing an Industrial Attachment OR were not successful in obtaining approval for the required Work Pass from the Ministry of Manpower, will have to complete a Research Project (12 weeks)



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
