In 2014, the UK Government introduced a nine-point grading scale (9 - 1) to raise standards and recognise top-performing students. This replaced the traditional A* - G grading. Since then, over 5 million GCSEs and International GCSEs have been awarded using the 9 - 1 grading scale, making it the most used and recognised grading scale for this qualification worldwide.

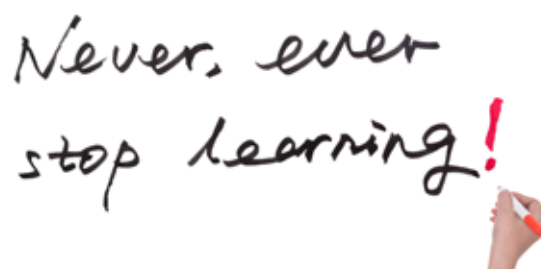
